- i. Kindly use Microsoft PowerPoint 2007 or above for the presentation
- ii. Maximum duration of presentation per person: 7 minutes
- iii. If any queries by judges or audiences for each presentation: 3 minutes
- iv. Use the following headings: Title slide containing title, name of the presenting author, co-authors, their designation and affiliation
- v. Disclaimer slide about conflict of interest and any financial implications
- vi. Brief introduction, aims and objectives, materials and methods, results, discussion, and conclusion slide with appropriate references
- vii. Use the tables and figures appropriately

POSTER GUIDELINES:

- 1. Use the standard poster size for printing in portrait format
- 2. Poster should include: Introduction, Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusions, References, Tables and figures for the original paper or case series. For a case report, use the following headings: introduction, case details and take-home message from the case report
